## A Text Can Be Worth Thousands Of Dollars



Senator John Kavanagh has been working diligently to introduce a bill that will ban texting while driving in Arizona. If passed, Senate Bill 1049 will impose hefty monetary fines if someone is caught texting while driving. Examples of the fines are as follows:

- \$100 fine for the first offense.
- \$300 fine for every consecutive ticket after the first violation.
- There will be a \$500 fine if an accident is caused while texting and driving.
- If texting while driving results in a fatal car accident, then there will be a \$10,000 fine imposed.
